Centrepay

Regular payments can be automatically deducted from your Centrelink benefits using Centrepay Deductions.

- You will also need NCCH's Centrelink Reference Number 555 012 631C

How to pay your rent

Deposit Book

- Deposit book to be requested through your Tenancy Manager
- NCCH will give you a bank deposit book which allows you to deposit rent into the nominated NCCH bank account.
